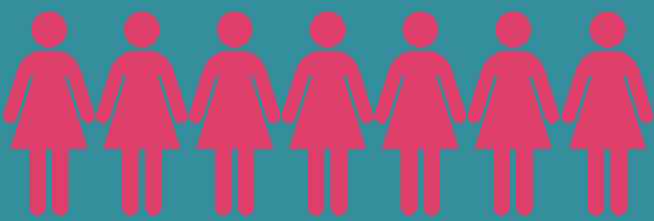
It is estimated that there will be **27,700** new cases of breast cancer in 2020

0.9%

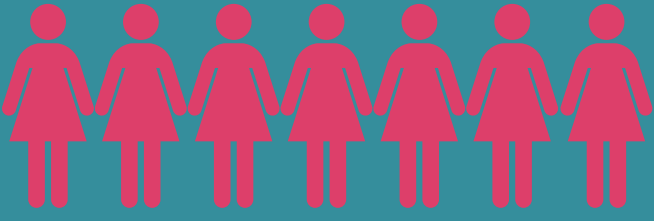


3rd BREAST CANCER IS THE 3RD MOST COMMON CANCER IN CANADA

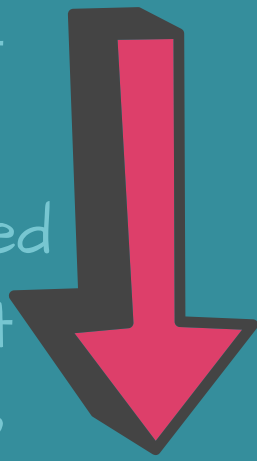
1st BUT IS THE MOST COMMON CANCER IN WOMEN



On average, 75 women will be diagnosed with breast cancer every day and 14 women will die from breast cancer every day.



Female breast cancer death rate has dropped by 49% since it peaked in 1986



88% of Canadian women diagnosed with breast cancer survive 5 or more years

83% of cases occur in women 50 years or older

Risk factors include:



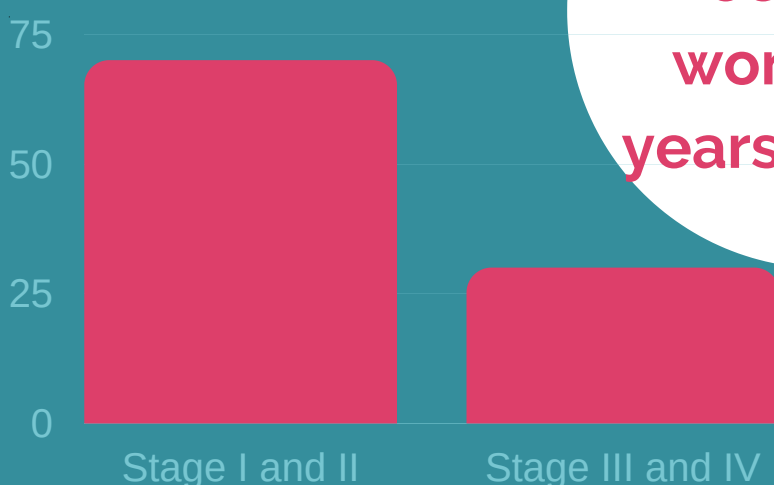
Age
